A step-by-step guide

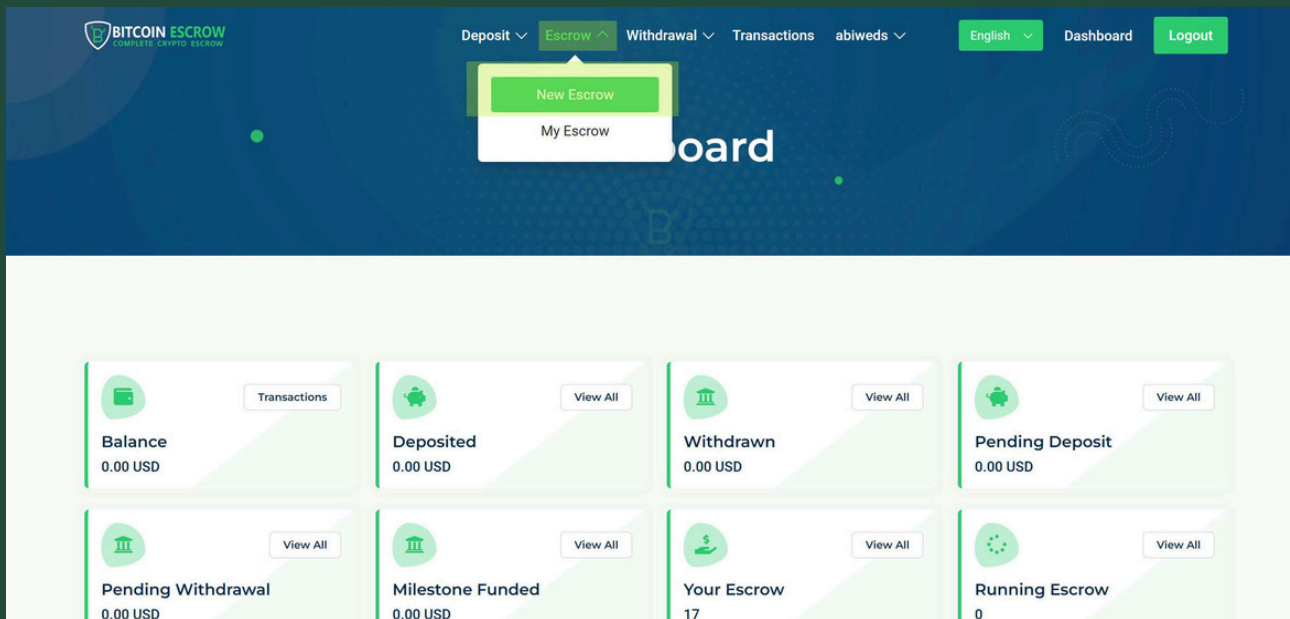
How to open an Escrow with your trade partner?

Step 1:

Please register an account first. You can visit " www.bitcoin-escrow.io " or use this link " https://bitcoin-escrow.io/register " to register directly.

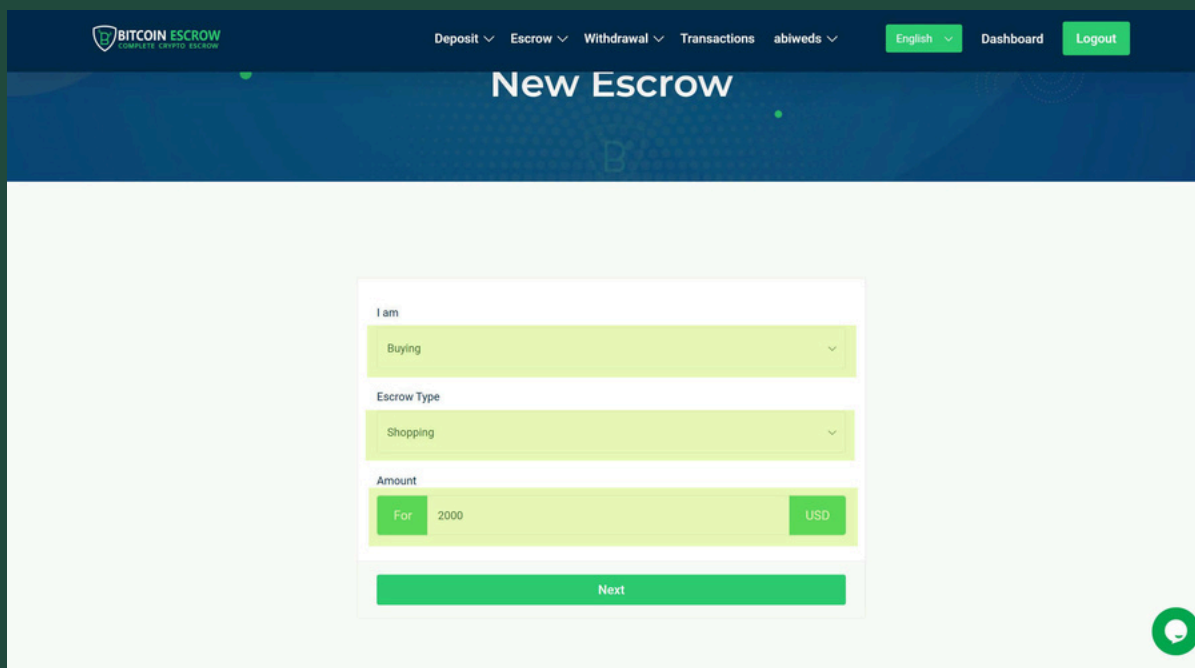
Step 2:

After registering and logging into your account, hover over the Escrow tab and click on the "New Escrow" button.



Step 3:

In this tutorial, we are placing a buy order. Please describe whether you are "Buying" or "Selling." Our escrow deal type is "Shopping," and the amount for this deal is \$2,000 USD. Please fill in these details according to your deal and click the "Next" button.



Step 4:

Add the 'Seller Email,' 'Title' of goods, and choose who will pay the 'Charges' for this deal. We are using a 50/50 split, meaning the 'Buyer' and 'Seller' both pay half and half. After filling in these options, add the trade 'Details.' Make sure that both you, as the 'Buyer,' and your 'Seller' agree with the terms added to the deal 'Details.' Seller will get an email once you open the Escrow. After reviewing the terms you provided, your trade partner can either accept or reject the deal. Please make sure to discuss everything with your trade partner before opening the Escrow.

Step 6: The escrow details are displayed. Now, you need to click the 'See Milestones' button for this deal. Since no milestone has been created yet, we need to create one.


Step 7: Click the 'Create Milestone' button.

Step 8:


Add the Milestone 'Title' and 'Amount' for your escrow deal, then click the 'Submit' button.

Step 10:

We will hover over the 'Select Gateway' option and choose the coin and network we are going to pay with. As you can see, I have chosen 'Tether USDT' on ETH, BSC, or Polygon only. This means I will pay with Tether USDT on the Ethereum (ETH) blockchain, Binance Smart Chain (BSC), or Polygon blockchain only. I will only send USDT from the Ethereum blockchain, not from any other chains or networks. I will click the 'Submit' button.

Step 11:

After sending the payment to the provided " Deposit To "address, I will type 'Payment has been sent' in the box below the 'Deposit To' address. We can paste our wallet address as well, the one we used to make the payment; it doesn't matter. But after making the payment, I must hit the 'Confirm' button.

Step 12:

After the transaction is confirmed, the payment will be added to our account, and we can check this in our 'Deposit History.' The seller will be notified that the buyer has funded the milestone, so they can 'Accept' the escrow deal.

Step 13:

The seller has accepted our terms, and our escrow is now active. We need to wait for the seller to ship our goods, which may take a few days depending on the shipping company they use. Once we receive the goods, we will inspect them. If everything is satisfactory, we will release the payment to the seller. If there is an issue, we will dispute the escrow and ship the goods back to the seller to get our funds refunded. We will receive the original amount back in our account, which we can then withdraw. However, the escrow fees will not be refunded. In this case, if we dispute the deal, we will get \$2,000 USD back, but the \$55 escrow fee will not be refunded.

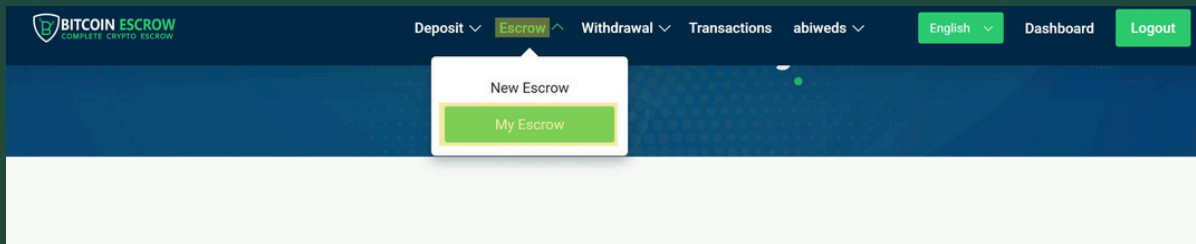

How to Dispute a trade?

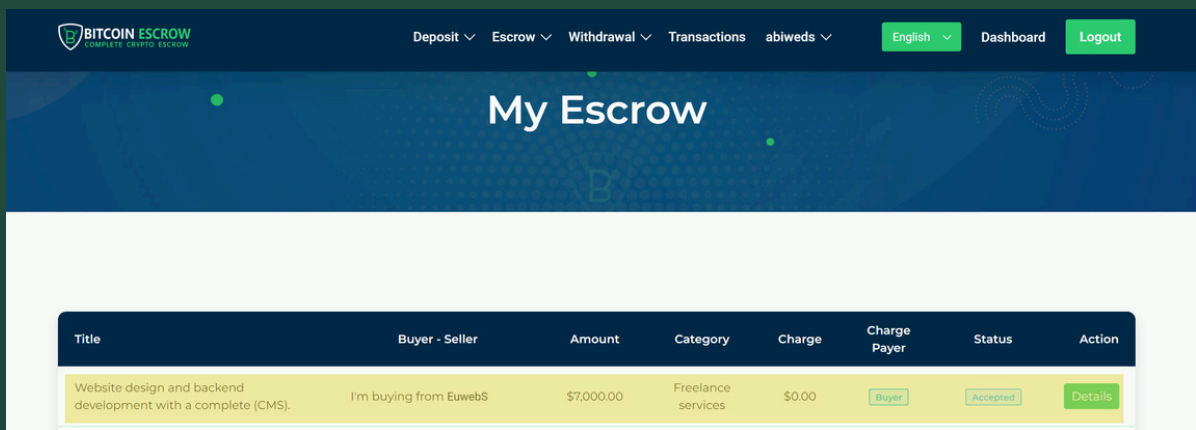
Step 1:

After logging in and accessing your account dashboard, hover over the 'Escrow' tab and click the 'My Escrow' button.



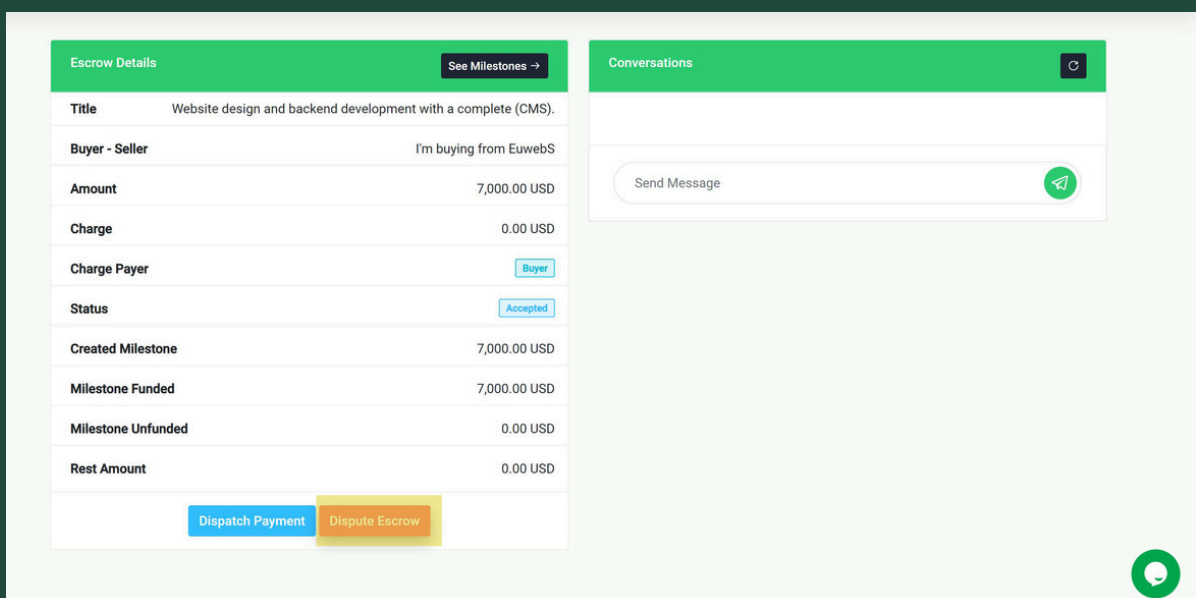
Step 2:

You will see all your escrow transactions here, including active ones and previously opened ones. To dispute a specific escrow trade, click on its 'details'.



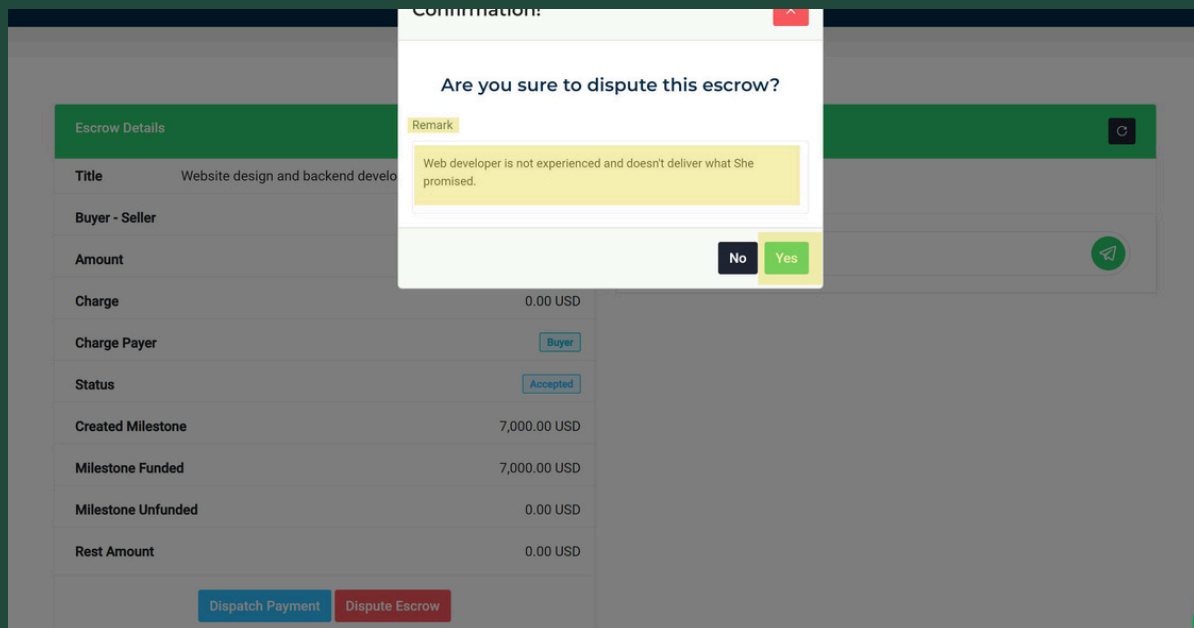
Step 3:

The trade details are opened and now you need to click on 'Dispute Escrow' button.



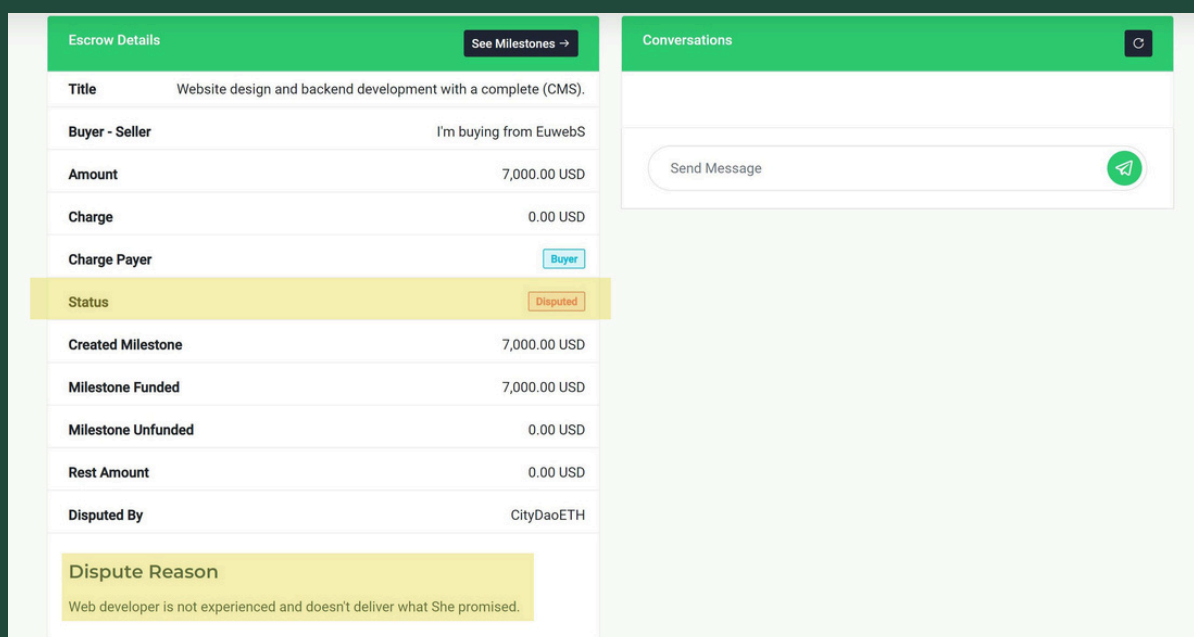
Step 4:

You will receive a confirmation popup where you can enter your remark. Explain the reason for disputing the transaction in this remark field. After entering your remark, click the 'Yes' button.



Step 5:

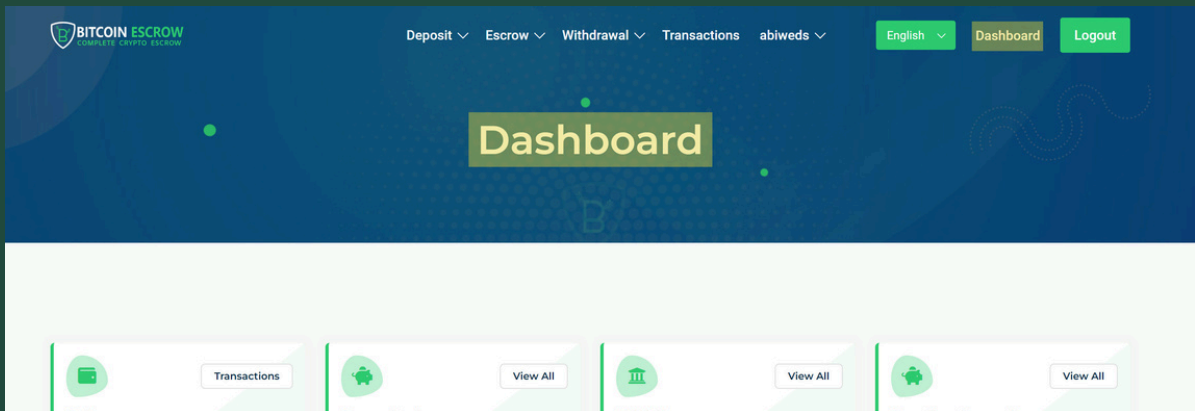
The dispute has been submitted. As you can see, the Escrow Status now shows 'Disputed.' Agents will investigate the case and contact you via the email address you used during account creation on the platform. The seller will also be informed about the dispute. You can provide evidence to agents to support your claim. All agents are highly professional and strive to respond within 12 to 24 hours. They are committed to ensuring a fair and impartial dispute resolution process based on the provided trade and authentic evidence.



How to Deposit into Your Account?

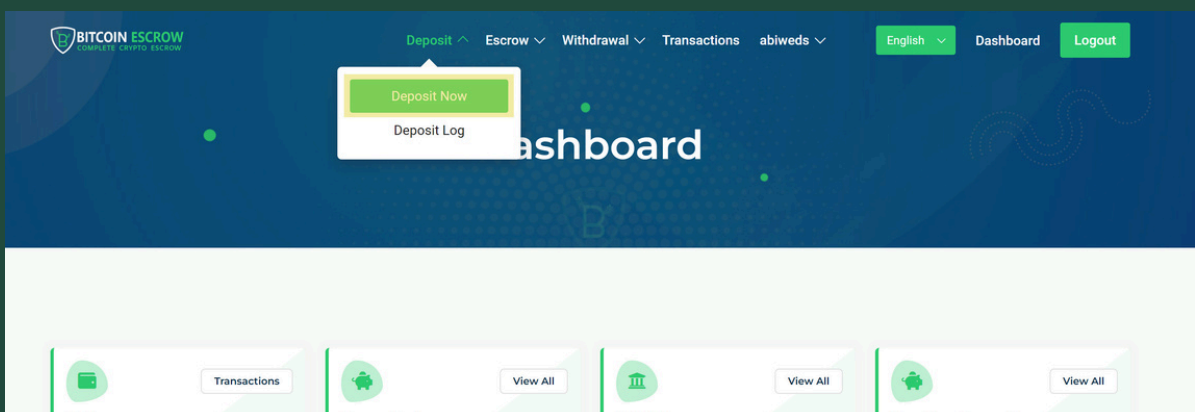
Step 1:

Log-in to your account. You can visit the website's homepage or use this direct link to log in: <https://bitcoin-escrow.io/login>



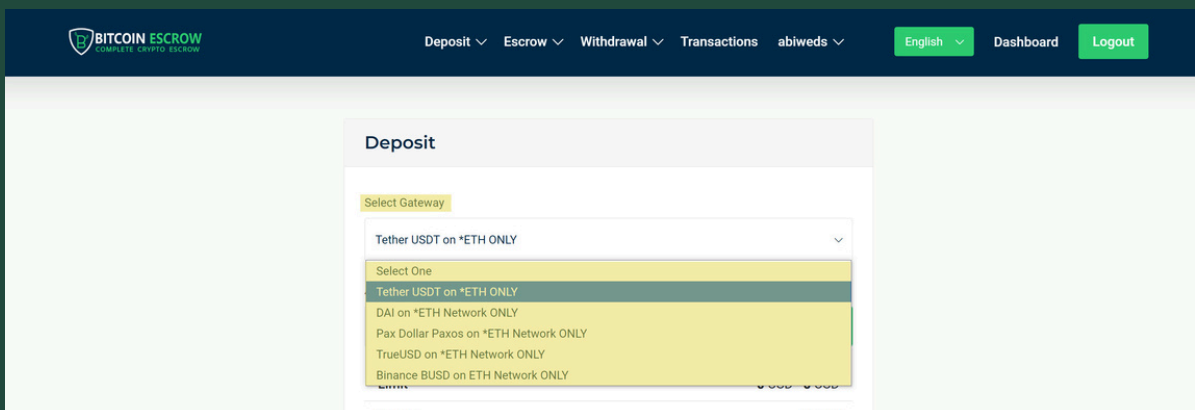
Step 2:

After logging in and accessing your account dashboard, hover over the 'Deposit' tab and click the 'Deposit Now' button.




Step 3:

After clicking the 'Deposit Now' button, go to the 'Select Gateway' dropdown and choose your desired payment method to make a deposit. I am going to use 'Tether USDT' as a payment method and will send USDT from the 'Ethereum Network'.



Step 4:

After selecting the payment 'gateway' type, we need to specify the amount we want to deposit. I'm going to make a \$10,000 deposit. For this amount, I need to pay a \$50 USD platform fee. These fees fluctuate, so they may not be the same for everyone. After typing the amount, we need to click the 'Submit' button.





Step 5:




After making the payment to the given address, type 'Payment has been sent' in the provided box below the Deposit address and click the 'Confirm' button.

The payment is pending. After the payment is confirmed, it will be credited to your account.



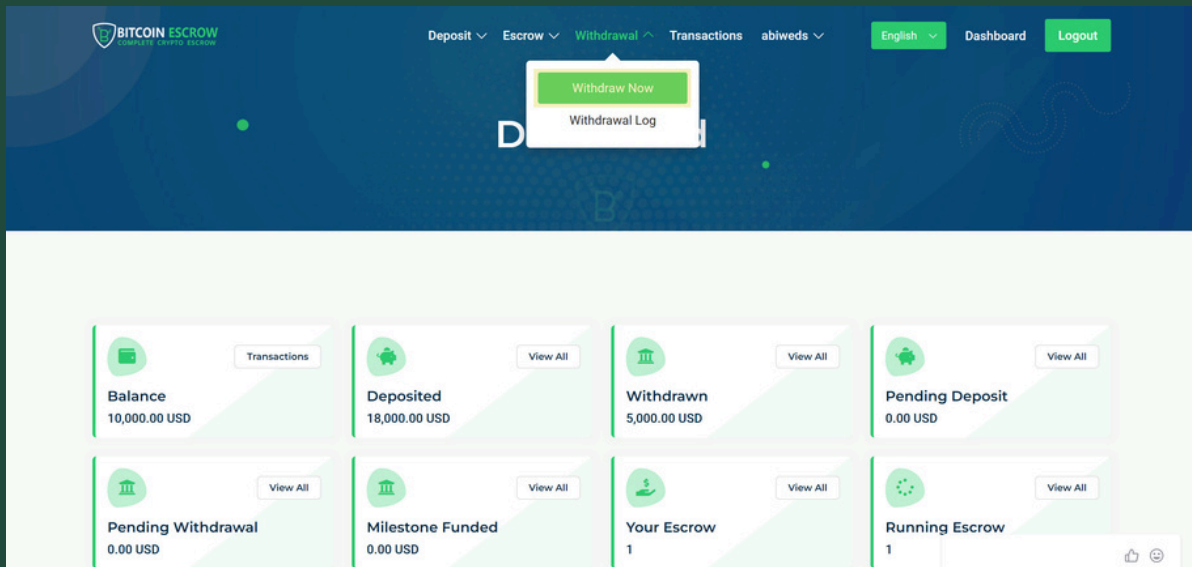
How to Withdraw from your account?

Step 1:

Log-in to your account. You can use this direct link to log-in: <https://bitcoin-escrow.io/login>

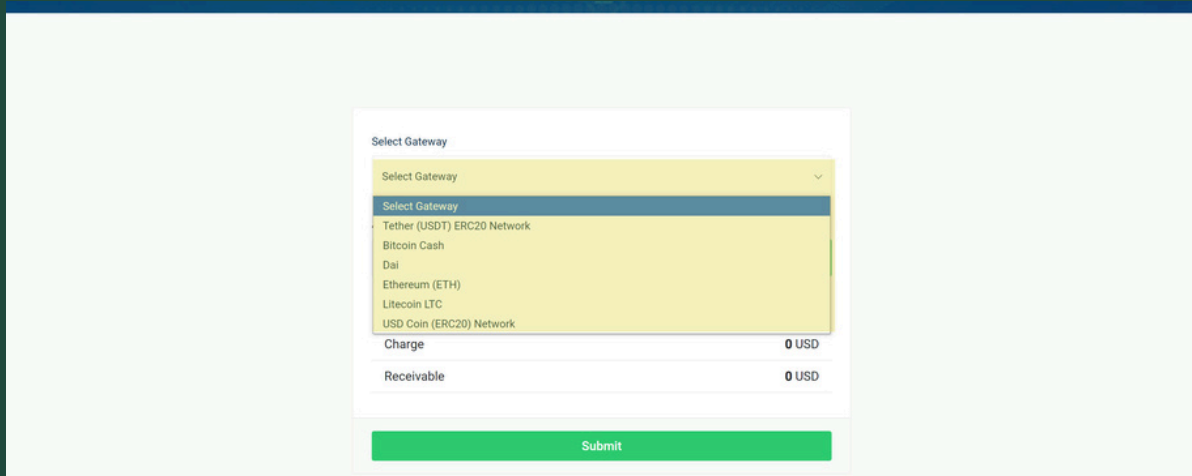
Step 2:

After logging in and accessing your account dashboard, hover over the 'Withdraw' tab and click the 'Withdraw Now' button.



Step 3:

We will see the Gateway options and need to choose which coin we want to withdraw. It's best to choose the same currency we used to deposit. In my case, I used 'Tether USDT,' so I want to withdraw my USDT from my Escrow account to my Wallet. Therefore, I will choose 'Tether USDT,' the same option I used for the deposit.



Step 4:

I selected 'Tether USDT' from the Gateway options and entered \$10,000 in the amount section, the same amount I used to deposit. You can enter your desired amount. After deducting platform and Ethereum network fees, I will receive ' \$9,950 ' back to my Desktop Wallet. Once I've entered the amount and verified the conversion rate, I'll click the 'Submit' button.

Step 5:

After that, I will enter my wallet address in the 'Wallet Address' field where I want to receive my USDT and click the 'Confirm' button.
